Candidates interested in becoming an Instructor must possess the following qualifications:

- Candidate must be 18 years or older and possess a valid Class M license
- Candidate must currently operate a motorcycle
- Candidate must have no criminal history and a clean driving record. The criminal history and driving record must reflect that within the last five years the applicant did not have any problems with violence, major traffic violations or driver's license suspensions. In addition, within the last seven years, an applicant cannot have any driver's license revocations or alcohol related driving convictions
- Candidate must possess excellent communication and customer service skills
- Candidate must have a sincere desire to help reduce motorcycle accidents, injuries, and deaths
